

With 4 hard fought rink wins, Gawler's Div 1 scored the maximum 18 points and in the process, leapfrogged their opponent, Tranmere, into 6th spot. Making the 18 shot win even more meritorious was the fact they were missing 2 skippers. With this week's game against 2nd placed Lockleys on their turf, another resolute performance will be needed to keep their season alive.

It was a disappointing result for the 3rd placed Div 4 team, falling to bottom placed Clearview by 5 shots. Teresa Dean's four continue to put in winning performances, 10 shots up at the end of play and Tim Hatcher's crew eked out the narrowest of wins to give the team 4 points for the day. Still perched in 3rd spot, they will be looking to take the lion's share of the points to maintain this position when they host Tranmere this week.

The Div 5 side completely dominated Hope Valley to take 14 of the 16 points up for grabs and sneak into the top 4. A huge 29 shots up by Gordon Nussey and his lads and solid contributions from the fours of Peter Jones and Kingsley Branson resulted in a 57 shot win to the home side.

It was tough going for the Div 6 side when they fronted 2nd placed Prospect Broadview on their home turf. Winning the rink of Bill Anderson and his boys saw them score 2 valuable points to keep themselves just clear of the relegation zone but it wasn't enough to prevent a 20 shot loss.
