

After winning its first game of the season, Gawler's division 2 team has dropped the next 3, this week against newly promoted Millswood by 32 shots. On a damp, heavy green, the home side played the conditions well and only Leigh Robert's lads managed to snatch a rink win to continue their good form. After only remaining in this division by a few points last season, it appears that the battle for survival is well and truly on.

The division 4 side hit back after last week's disappointing performance, beating higher ranked Rosewater by 30 shots.
