**SUBJECT: 2018-19 Wednesday Pennants – Round 12**

The forecast for Wednesday 16 January 2019 at 4.30 pm on Monday 14 January 2019 on the BOM website is 40 degrees Celsius.

As per Rule 7.4 of the Metropolitan Pennant Conditions of Play 2018-19, **all Round 12 Wednesday Pennant matches will be played with practice ends commencing at 9.15am**, under the conditions as described in Rule 7.2.

**It is possible, but not likely, that we will review the decision about whether matches will be played once tomorrow (Tuesday) afternoon's forecast for Wednesday is released.** If any further change is made a memo will be sent to clubs and information will be made available on the MBA website and Facebook.

Clubs are reminded that they need to have a dedicated person monitoring the temperature to ensure that games do not continue if the cut-off temperature (38 degrees Celsius) is reached (as per Rule 7.2).

Member Clubs are also reminded that for all matches that are played on days of extreme heat, it is recommended that mid-game breaks are only taken upon mutual agreement between Side Managers. However, Side Managers are advised to be mindful of the duty of care for all participants and monitor the conditions and consider breaks, if necessary, to provide participants with opportunities to hydrate.
